Playing Rules

1. Play is only allowed from the yellow markers.
2. Only wide-wheeled trolleys are allowed on the Course.
3. Your allocated starting times must be adhered to.
4. If you are late for your tee reservation, you will have to wait for other players.
5. Texas Scrambles and Medal Play are not allowed.

Dress Rules - In order to ensure there are no misunderstandings and you have a pleasant visit to Finchley we ask that your guests kindly observe the following:

- Denim is unacceptable in the clubhouse and on the course.
- Shorts may be worn on the course and in the clubhouse, however, they must be tailored and worn either with long socks of any colour or **short socks that are predominately white** (not black working socks). Suitable socks are available for purchase from our golf professional shop.
- Track suits are not allowed in the clubhouse or on the course.
- No form of golf shoe (including spikeless) may be worn in the clubhouse except in the spike bar. Do not walk without shoes anywhere in the clubhouse. Please change into normal shoes, **trainers and beach shoes are not allowed.**
- Dirty, wet or soiled golf clothing may not be worn in the lounge bar or dining room.
- Only shirts with collars may be worn in the clubhouse or on the course.
- No shirts outside of trousers in the clubhouse or on the course.
- Caps must be worn with the peak at the front when on the course. No headgear of any kind (including sun visors) may be worn in the clubhouse.
- Players are expected to change into a jacket and tie for their evening meal in the dining room.
- **Mobile telephones** are not permitted in the clubhouse or on the course.

Those not complying with the Club's Dress Rules above will neither be permitted to play golf nor enter the Clubhouse

Course Etiquette:

Slow Play - Please arrange for Stableford Golf and encourage those not able to score on a particular hole to pick up and move on. As a guide, a 2 ball round should be comfortably possible in under 3 hours and a 3/4 ball round in under 4½ hours.

Bunkers - All bunkers have a rake available. Please ensure its use when appropriate and thereafter leave the rake in the bunker and in such a position that the handle is readily available for future use.

Pitch Marks - If every time a golfer reached a Green he repaired a pitch mark there would be no pitch marks left. Please ensure that your Members are aware of this situation and carry a pitch fork.

Divots - Divots should be replaced and stamped into the ground to assist repair.
